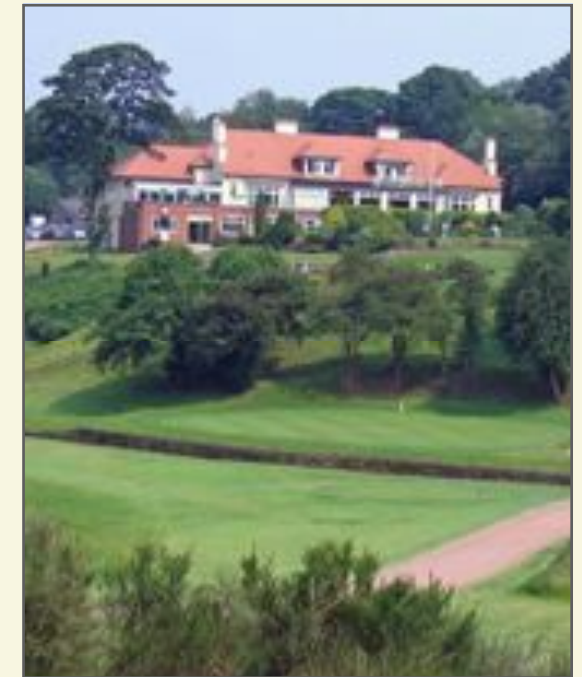

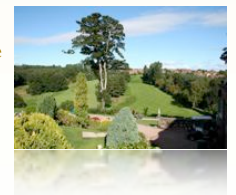

Established in 1914 and designed by Dr Alister MacKenzie, Oakdale's unique mix of moor and parkland has earned it a reputation to rival even the very best venues in Northern England.

Moreover, few facilities offer such a close tie with accommodation in the adjacent town centre, providing the ideal stay and play situation.

At just under 6,500 yards, the course offers a true test to golfers of varying abilities, generous fairways and beautiful scenery abounds.

Set in 130 acres of naturally undulating terrain, you can expect to come across a diverse range of wildlife, with foxes and roe deer a common sight.

With no two holes the same, it's a well know fact that scoring at Oakdale depends on how well you negotiate the par 3s with both the 9th and 12th protected by water.

A famous first for the Club was in 1948 when it played host to the North British Harrogate Professional tournament and initiated a feature

that has become an accepted part and parcel of the game. With the help of the quaintly-named North British Rubber company, the first grandstand was erected for spectators at a golf event in Britain. Oakdale's elevated position was regarded as being perfect for the innovation at the tournament carrying the admirable prize fund of 2.000 guineas. With an understandable lack of perception, a commentary suggested: 'Though grandstand golf may not become a permanent feature...' How wrong can you be.

More recently the Club has invested both in the Clubhouse and on the course. Improvements by way of new bunkering and



other features to allow for the modern game whilst sticking to MacKenzie principles was the brief given to Hawtree and Partners whose plan is being followed by the Clubs Committee much to the delight of members and visitors alike. Back in the Clubhouse a newly refurbished dining room awaits with catering by the renowned Chef Darren Gladman and his team.
